

German Battery Act & Regulation (EU) 2023/1542

Batteries are thus an important source of energy and one of the key enablers for sustainable development, green mobility, clean energy and climate neutrality. Wiesemann & Theis GmbH therefore welcomes cross-border efforts to improve the environmental balance of batteries over their entire life cycle.

Button cells are used in some devices of our Web-IO® family. The button cells come from a well-known brand manufacturer and are purchased by us in Germany. According to the manufacturer's information, the button cells are explicitly **free of mercury, cadmium and lead**.

Wiesemann & Theis GmbH is **registered** in the battery register as a producer with the brand name W&T and the battery type portable batteries: **DE 64514633**

Since we purchase the button cells we use in Germany, they are already considered “placed on the market” within the meaning of the Battery Regulation. Of course, we will also fulfill the obligations arising from the battery regulation for “distributors” regarding button cells in due course.

We will continue to monitor the issue and update this document as necessary.
