

Regulation (EU) 2017/852 „Mercury Regulation“ (e.g. on the Minamata Convention)

Mercury is a highly toxic substance that poses a significant global threat to human health, ecosystems and natural flora and fauna. Wiesemann & Theis GmbH therefore welcomes the cross-border efforts to reduce anthropogenic emissions and releases of mercury and mercury compounds.

Neither mercury nor mercury compounds are used in the manufacturing processes at Wiesemann & Theis GmbH.

We are also not aware of any violation of Regulation (EU) 2017/852 with regard to the parts and components we use, which come exclusively from reputable manufacturers and which we generally purchase from distributors we have trusted for many years.

In particular, the button cells we use in some devices of our Web-IO® family are explicitly mercury-free according to the manufacturer's specifications.

We will continue to monitor the issue and update this document as necessary.
