

Per- and polyfluorinated substances (PFAS)

The group of PFAS, a chemical group with over 10,000 different substances, is used in a wide range of applications - from cosmetics and cookware to paper coatings and surface treatments of metals and plastics.

PFAS do not occur naturally in the environment, but they are extremely persistent, thermally and chemically stable and they accumulate in various organisms, some of them also in humans.

Wiesemann & Theis GmbH acknowledges and supports international efforts to decrease the usage and release of PFAS, as well as their accumulation in the food chain, due to the potential risks they may cause to human health and the environment.

Wiesemann & Theis GmbH does not manufacture perfluorinated and polyfluorinated substances, nor are these substances added to our products during the production process.

We are also not aware of any use of PFAS in the parts and components we use, which come exclusively from reputable manufacturers and which we generally purchase from distributors we trust for many years.

To ensure that our products always comply with current regulatory requirements, we check them regularly and are in close contact with our suppliers.
